



ALLEGATIONS:

1) The attached 2019 registration clearly shows candidate committee marked and that Gutowsky knew to sign the form. Thus, she is knowledgeable and violations must be considered intentional.

2) The attached 2021 registration clearly shows candidate committee marked and that Gutowsky failed to sign the form as required by 7-134(a)(8).

THIS IS THE FIRST 7-134 VIOLATION, \$150!

3) The attached 7-134 screenshot clearly shows the section was last updated in 2020, under Gutowsky's term. As she considered and voted for this change, she is knowledgeable and violations must be considered intentional.

4) The attached 7-143 screenshot clearly shows the section was last updated in 2020 under Gutowsky's term. As she considered and voted for this change, she is knowledgeable and violations must be considered intentional, especially since first and second time criminal charges were changed to civil fines due to the criminal charges she faced as a result of her first time 7-140 violations in the 2019 campaign.

5) As the registration form was not properly signed as required by (2) below, the registration must be declared null and void as of the date of submittal. It is not the City's job to validate that such forms are error free, that is the job of those affixing their names to the documents. Likewise, it is the public's job to review and file complaints. Otherwise, there would be a validation process. Note, the form only has a "rec'd" box, not an "approved" box. It was the candidate's job to make sure the registration was valid, as the candidate knows per her court assignment in 2019 that can be found on page 103 of the ethics complaint. In fact, it is illegal for the City to tell the candidate the form is not legal, as that would be prohibited legal advice. As the registration is null and void, each contribution and expenditure made prior to a valid registration being submitted, is a violation of 7-134(a). That means that contributions and expenditures made even after this complaint is filed are subject fines and penalties until a proper registration is filed.

6) The whois reference below clearly shows the susangutowsky.com registration occurring on 2020-12-21T20:47:12Z. GoDaddy charges for domains (see attached) and there is a small (\$0.18/year) ICANN fee for every domain. This is undeniable evidence of a campaign expenditure before a valid committee registration.

THIS IS THE SECOND 7-134 VIOLATION, PLUS \$300!

7) In order to make the expenditure above, a contribution must have been made. The expenditure is undeniable evidence of a corresponding campaign contribution before a valid committee registration.

THIS IS THE THIRD 7-134 VIOLATION, PLUS ANOTHER \$300!

8) The curl output below shows that susangutowsky.com (no dash) redirects (via the Location line), to "susan-gutowsky.com" (with a dash). Where did susan-gutowsky.com come from? It does not appear on any of Gutowsky's 2021 campaign filings. However, susan-gutowsky.com was the web-site registered for her 2019 campaign that was terminated on 2019-05-07. As an ICANN accredited registrar, Wild West must charge the \$0.18/year fee. By redirecting susangutowsky.com to susan-gutowsky.com, susan-gutowsky.com is being used for the 2021 campaign. But, whois shows the created and last updated date as 2018-12-27 with an expiration date of 2023-12-27. This means that 2019 campaign money was expended for susan-gutowsky.com in 2018 to hold susan-gutowsky.com until 2023. In other words, 2019 campaign

funds were used to provide the 2021 campaign site. As such funds were expended before the creation of the 2021 candidate committee, this is another 7-134(a) violation. NOTE: This item is about the linking from susangutowsky.com to susan-gutowsky.com that occurred before 2021-01-27.

THIS IS THE FOURTH 7-134 VIOLATION, PLUS ANOTHER \$300!

9) On 2021-01-27, gutowsky's web-site on the City's election page magically changed from susangutowsky.com to susan-gutowsky.com, without an amended registration being filed. How did this happen? Without an updated registration, anyone looking at the registration could go to the security error web-site and be scammed. In any case, it leaves no doubt that the 2019 domain is being used for the 2021 campaign, which, as shown, in item 8 above was paid for prior to the 2019-05-07 termination report. See related email thread attached. NOTE: This item is about the direct use of susan-gutowsky.com that occurred on and after 2021-01-27.

THIS IS THE FIFTH 7-134 VIOLATION, PLUS ANOTHER \$300!

10) NOTE: While the 60-day limit to report the following issues has passed, the following are worth noting for the purpose of denying a lenient penalty in this case. The 2019 registration was signed on 2019-01-02, but the WildWest susangutowsky.com domain was bought several days earlier on 2018-12-27. Also, the 2019-05-07 termination report, shows a zero balance, but in fact, the susan-gutowsky.com asset was kept. This asset should have been disposed of prior to termination. Also, see the excerpt from the 2019 first campaign finance report and the facebook launch event, the report shows items purchased on 2019-02-19 for the event that took place on 2019-02-17, two days earlier. This establishes a clear pattern of poor compliance. The City must not continue to support White Privilege and systemic racism by providing leniency in this case that has been denied to People of Color.

11) There are now two or more Article 7 violations. The 7-143(b) (3) criminal penalty is now required. Also note that these 2021 violation occurred even after the candidate was offered extreme leniency in her 2019 7-140 case and her 2020-07-31 ethics case. The candidate has used up all her leniency credits and must be subject to the maximum penalty allowed by law. Otherwise, the City risks promoting White Privilege and systemic racism by providing leniency in this case that has been denied to People of Color.

12) The City is obligated to obtain all bank and other financial records and to treat each contribution and expenditure as a separate 7-134(a) violation and apply the applicable 7-143 fine and criminal charges.

CONCLUSION:

By failing to sign the registration, the registration must be revoked, and all contributions and expenditures made under the null and void registration must be subject to both civil and criminal penalties.

FINAL NOTE:

Anything other than the maximum penalty creates election irregularities that many are complaining about at the national level. It is critical that the City avoid getting caught up in this.

APPLICABLE LAW:

Sec. 7-134. - Registration of committees; termination.

(a) All candidate committees, political committees and issue committees shall register with the City Clerk before ACCEPTING ANY CONTRIBUTIONS or MAKING ANY EXPENDITURES. Registration must be on a form provided by

the City Clerk and must include the following, together with any other information required to complete the registration form.

...

(8) An acknowledgment and certification signed BY THE REGISTERED AGENT and, FOR ANY CANDIDATE COMMITTEE, THE CANDIDATE.

Sec. 7-143. - Violations and penalties.

(a) Except as provided in Subparagraph (e) herein, any person who knowingly violates or fails to comply with the provisions of this Article as set forth in the following schedule commits a civil infraction and IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL PENALTY AS FOLLOWS:

7-134 - REGISTRATION OF COMMITTEES; TERMINATION. \$150 FIRST OFFENSE; \$300 EACH SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE

(b) ANY PERSON WHO UNDERTAKES ANY OF THE FOLLOWING COMMITS A MISDEMEANOR and is subject to a fine or imprisonment in accordance with § 1-15:

(1) Knowingly violates § 7-136 with the intent to fraudulently misrepresent campaign contributions or expenditures on a disclosure report;

(2) Knowingly violates § 7-142; or

(3) IS FOUND LIABLE FOR A VIOLATION AFTER THE PERSON HAS BEEN FOUND LIABLE FOR TWO (2) OR MORE VIOLATIONS UNDER THIS ARTICLE IN A SINGLE ELECTION CYCLE.

(a) All candidate committees, political committees and issue committees shall register with the City Clerk before accepting any contributions or making any expenditures. Registration must be on a form provided by the City Clerk and must include the following, together with any other information required to complete the registration form.

- (1) The committee's full name, spelling out any acronyms used therein;
 - (2) The name of a natural person authorized to act as a registered agent for the committee;
 - (3) A current street address, mailing address (if different from the street address), telephone number and email address for the principal place of business of the committee;
 - (4) A current mailing address, telephone number and email address for the registered agent;
 - (5) The purpose or nature of interest of the committee;
 - (6) The date of the election regarding which the committee intends to be active;
 - (7) The name and address of the financial institution in which all contributions received by the committee are deposited in a separate account bearing the name of the committee, and documentation of such account reasonably satisfactory to the City Clerk; and
 - (8) An acknowledgement and certification signed by the registered agent and, for any candidate committee, the candidate.
- (b) A registered committee must promptly provide updated address, telephone and email information to the City Clerk upon the change of such information for the committee or the registered agent of the committee, or any change in financial institution or account.
- (c) Any candidate committee, political committee, issue committee or registered small-scale issue committee that has registered with the City Clerk, but has not engaged in any election activities or reported any contributions accepted or expenditures made, may terminate at any time by filing an amended committee registration indicating the nature of the amendment is termination of the committee and verifying that no contributions have been received or expenditures made since registration occurred pursuant to § 7-134. Alternatively, the committee shall file a campaign report indicating no contributions have been received or expenditures made, and indicating it is a termination report.
- (d) Any political committee, issue committee or registered small-scale issue committee that has not taken the necessary steps to terminate pursuant to Subsection (c) above must have properly disposed of all funds and must file a termination report no later than seventy (70) days after the election.

(b) Any person who undertakes any of the following commits a misdemeanor and is subject to a fine or imprisonment in accordance with § 1-15:

- (1) Knowingly violates § 7-136 with the intent to fraudulently misrepresent campaign contributions or expenditures on a disclosure report;
- (2) Knowingly violates § 7-142; or
- (3) Is found liable for a violation after the person has been found liable for two (2) or more violations under this Article in a single election cycle.

(c) Failure to comply with the provisions of this Article shall have no effect on the validity of any election, except as expressly required by the City Charter.

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

Certainly don't want to find out that a spammer hijacked her site and people are paying the scammer when they think they are making donations to her campaign. Not the City's job to research, especially in the case of a sitting council member, gives the appearance of special treatment.
