Pursuant Section 7-145(6), the City Attorney, by and through special counsel, and on receipt of the Campaign Committee's response to the complaints, must determine if the violation has been cured and, if so, whether the Campaign Committee has substantially complied with its legal obligations under Chapter 7, Article V of the Code.

The information you provided on January 10 on behalf of the Babbitt campaign documenting mitigation performed relating to the violation alleged in the election complaint was promptly provided to the City Attorney. The City appreciates your willingness to engage in understanding the nature of the alleged violation and in undertaking action intended to cure the violation.

The City Attorney, by and through special counsel, has indicated the proof of mitigation performed submitted is consistent with the plan agreed to and acts as an adequate cure of the violation pursuant to Section 7-145(d)(6) of City Code.
