
Dear Mr. Adams:

I am writing regarding a complaint filed by Robbie Moreland against Alexander Adams alleging a violation of Chapter 7, Article V of the Code of the City of Fort Collins. Ms. Moreland filed a complaint with the Fort Collins City Clerk's Office on December 13, 2023.

Pursuant to Code Section 7-145(d)(2), I forwarded the complaints to the City Attorney for her review. The City Attorney retained special counsel, and the special counsel, Corey Y. Hoffmann of the law firm of Hoffmann, Parker, Wilson & Carberry, P.C., has notified me that the allegations satisfy the three elements set forth in Section 7-145(d)(2). More specifically, Ms. Moreland alleged that Mr. Adams's campaign finance reports, filed on October 24, 2023, November 3, 2023, and December 12, 2023, respectively, reflected incorrect total funds on hand indicated at the end of the reporting periods.

In accordance with Section 7-145(d)(4), you would typically have seven (7) days to cure the violations or provide an explanation that would otherwise indicate the above communication did not violate the Code, or the City would consider additional action in accordance with Article V of Chapter 7 of the Code. However, because you have already provided corrected campaign finance reports with updated and corrected calculations, no other response is required at this time and the violations alleged in the Complaint filed against you are considered to be fully cured.
