## **NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF CITY OF FORT COLLINS, COLORADO, EMERGENCY RULES AND REGULATIONS No. 2020-18**

To all persons take notice:

On May 28, 2020, under the authority of Sec. 2-671(a)(6) of the City Code, I established Emergency Rules and Regulation No. 2020-18 (“Rule 18”) requiring the public to utilize face coverings inside of public places within the entirety of the territory of the City of Fort Collins, Colorado, to slow the spread of the COVID-19 virus. Specifically, Rule 18 required all persons to wear face coverings when: (i) entering and while inside any enclosed area, including retail and commercial businesses or on-site service providers, to which the public is invited or in which workers, including volunteers, from more than one household are present; (ii) in any City of Fort Collins building or indoor facility; (iii) in any public transportation, including City Transfort buses and bus shelters; (iv) in any other public indoor place where persons are unable to maintain safe social distancing (six or more feet separation) from others not of their own household; (v) in any outdoor seating or patio area of a place that does not fall within an exception for eating and drinking; or (vi) where otherwise required by State or County order.

On May 13, 2021, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (“CDC”) issued new guidelines for the wearing of face coverings. The CDC now recommends that fully vaccinated persons no longer need to wear a face covering or to physically distance.

On or about May 14, 2021, the Larimer County Department of Health & Environment announced that it will end local county public health orders, including those related to the wearing of face coverings inside of public places, related to COVID-19 at 11:59 p.m. on May 16, 2021, and that beginning 12:00 a.m. on May 17, 2021, Larimer County will be required to follow statewide public health orders.

Also on May 14, 2021, Colorado Governor Jared Polis issued Executive Order D 2021 103 significantly amending and restating his previous executive orders relating to face coverings to align with the recent guidance provided by the CDC. This was followed up on May 14, 2021, with the issuance of the Colorado Department of Health and Environment’s Second Amended Public Health Order 20-38 to implement Executive Order D 2021 103.

Considering the foregoing change of conditions, I hereby **terminate Rule 18**, which shall be of no further force or effect upon the effective date of this Notice of Termination, as set forth below.
