Proposed Locally Preferred Alternative

Road

Widen Harmony (Boardwalk to College) to 6 Lanes & Intersection improvements

Bus

Enhanced bus service with queue jumps at major intersections, increased frequency with improved bus plazas

Walk

Fill in missing sidewalks, pursue over or underpasses and improve crossings at signalized intersections

Bike

Buffered bike lanes with green marking, along with detached multi-use paths
