

ORDINANCE NO. 127, 2010
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS
AMENDING SECTION 27-38 OF THE CITY CODE RELATING TO
THE LICENSING OF ARBORISTS

WHEREAS, Under Section 27-34 of the City Code a business must have an arborist license issued by the City Forester before doing work, for commercial gain or profit, that involves making cuts on trees ten feet or higher off of the ground or applying pesticides to trees; and

WHEREAS, Section 27-38 of the City Code states that licenses issued pursuant to Chapter 27 will expire one year after they are issued, and renewal applications must be submitted to the City Forester; and


WHEREAS, Forestry Division staff would like to make the license renewal process more efficient by having all City-issued arborist licenses come up for renewal at the same time each year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS that Section 27-38 of the City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:


Sec. 27-38. License fees; expiration; renewal.

No license shall be issued until the applicant has paid a license fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.). Every license issued hereunder shall expire on January 31 of the following year. Renewal applications must be submitted at the office of the City Forester.




