Volunteer Job Title: Butterfly House Volunteer

Job Description: Volunteering in our Butterfly House is both educational and rewarding! Butterfly House volunteers are responsible for maintaining USDA containment standards, helping to ensure excellent guest experience, and enhance guest takeaways through interpretation and education.

Primary Activities:

- Welcome all guests by giving them a short orientation to the Butterfly House rules and keeping track of tickets.
- Ensuring the butterflies stay in the house as per the Butterfly House training.
- Check guests clothing and belongings as they leave to ensure there are no butterflies leaving the house.
- Ensure guests are not leaving the house with butterflies or plant material.
- Ensure guests are staying on the path and not disturbing the butterflies or plant material.
- Provide interpretive education in the Butterfly House

Expectations:

- Interest in, and knowledge about (will be provided at training) butterflies and tropical plants.
- Enthusiasm for sharing a love of gardening and the natural world with people of all ages.
- Excellent customer service skills.
- 1.5 hour pre-recorded virtual training and 2-hour on site shadow training. Both can be flexible to your schedule.
- You must be 15 (with parental approval if younger than 18) or older to apply for this position.

Time Commitment and Availability: Butterfly House shifts are 2.25 hours in length, and you can sign up for as many or as few as you want. There is no minimum commitment. Shifts occur 7 days a week between 9:45 am and 4:00 pm.
