Committee Purpose:

Advisory Committee to the City Manager to consider key questions and offer recommendations regarding the potential development of permanent homeless shelter in Fort Collins.

Role of Members:

- Advise City Manager on key considerations from varying perspectives
- Represent community interests to identify opportunities and concerns related to key questions for consideration

Key Questions for Advisory Committee Consideration:

1. What amenities and services should be co-located with a 24/7 shelter?
2. Where can a new 24/7 homeless shelter be located?
 - a. What trade-offs will exist?
3. How can impacts be addressed and mitigated?
 - a. What type of engagement is needed?
4. What funding considerations are recommended?

Group Norms:

- Speak from personal experience
- Lead with inquiry and curiosity
- Value diverse perspectives
- Get comfortable with discomfort
- Acknowledge the difference between intent and impact
- Use the buffet rule (firsts before seconds)
- Speak Directly and Honestly
