#### Key Questions for Advisory Committee Consideration:

- 1. What amenities and services should be co-located with a 24/7 shelter?
- 2. Where can a new 24/7 homeless shelter be located?
  - a. What trade-offs will exist?
- 3. How can impacts be addressed and mitigated?
  - a. What type of engagement is needed?
- 4. What funding considerations are recommended?
