Requirements:

- Sign a waiver
- Be 18 or volunteer with an adult
- Have transportation
- Access to the internet
- Ability to work on your own

Job Duties:

- Visit natural area once each month to pick up litter
- Report hours and maintenance issues in Engage
- Implement safe practices of yourself and all others involved during site visits
