Overview:

Requirements:

- Be 18 or volunteer with an adult
- Have transportation

- Previous gardening experience

Job Duties:

- Attend orientation and initial training
- Coordinate with Natural Areas Department (NAD) staff to develop tasks
- Coordinate schedule with Volunteer Coordinator
- Input volunteer hours in Engage
- Pull weeds, prune and clear garden beds as directed by NAD staff
- Attend continuing education as available
