

SOAPSTONE PRAIRIE NATURAL AREA EMERGENCY INFORMATION

In Case of an Emergency

- Call 911. Ask dispatch to also call Larimer County Rangers at nearby Red Mountain Open Space.
- If you do not have cell coverage, use the radio to contact a ranger or staff member who can call 911 (Soapstone Prairie only). If you do not have a radio, ask others with different cell phone carriers to call 911 or to go to a place with cell coverage.
- Call the Rangers at 970-416-2147 to let them know of the situation.
- Rangers have medical equipment and training. There is a medical supply bag and Helivac kit at the Gate Attendant Station.
- After talking with emergency personnel, if possible send another person to the trailhead or trail junctions to direct emergency responders to the location of the emergency.

Soapstone Prairie Natural Area Property Addresses and Driving Directions

Gate Attendant Station – 22998 Rawhide Flats Road

Ranch Headquarters – 3700 Soapstone Road; no public access–emergency access only.

From Fort Collins via 22998 Rawhide Flats Road:

From Highway 1 and Highway 287 (College Ave) go 3.7 miles to CR 15 (to Waverly).

Turn left on CR 15; go north to Rawhide Flats Road approximately 13.7 miles.

Turn right Rawhide Flats Road and go 6.4 miles to south parking lot; 9.4 miles to north parking lot.

From Terry Ranch Road in Wyoming

From I-25, take Exit 2 at Terry Ranch Road; turn right at stop sign on exit ramp.

Turn right at next stop sign on Frontage Road.

Proceed south to Terry Bison Ranch, approximately 2 miles.

Turn right under I-25, cross RR tracks heading west to Duck Creek.

Duck Creek ½ mile to road split – take Soapstone Road (left).

On Soapstone Road go approximately 5 miles to ranch headquarters at 3700 Soapstone Road.

From the east – 3700 Soapstone Road

Take I-25 north to Carr exit.

Travel north on Frontage Road, which is located on the east side of I-25 to Terry Bison.

At Terry Bison go west to Duck Creek.

Go under I-25 over RR tracks.

Duck Creek splits at ½ mile; take Soapstone Road to the left.

From Red Mountain Open Space

From RMOS parking lot on Antelope Valley Road, go south approximately 8 miles.

Turn left on CR 19N, 0.5 miles to CR 84W.

Turn right on CR 84W and go 4 miles to Rawhide Flats Road.

Turn right Rawhide Flats Road and go 6.4 miles to south parking lot; 9.4 miles to north parking lot.

In Case of an Emergency

- Call 911.

Bobcat Ridge Natural Area Property Addresses and Driving Directions

Parking Lot – 10184 W. County Road 32C

Gate at end of CR 32C – 10360 Bobcat Ridge Road; no public access–emergency access only.

From Fort Collins

From Taft Hill Road, take Harmony Road west. It turns into CR 38E.

Go 10 miles on CR38 E to Masonville.

Go left (south) at the Masonville Mercantile onto CR 27.

Follow CR 27 about ½ mile to CR 32C.

Turn right and go west ½ mile to the Bobcat Ridge parking lot.

Directions from Loveland

From Wilson Avenue and Highway 34, go west about 4.5 miles.

Turn north on CR 27 by Big Thompson Elementary and go 4.5 miles.

Turn left on CR 32C and go west ½ mile to the Bobcat Ridge parking lot.
