*Lithospermum incisum*  
(Borage family)

native

common prairie plant  
Roots have been used to make tea and cooked as a vegetable. Most parts have had some medicinal use

**Western wallflower**  
*Erysimum asperum*  
(Mustard family)

native

fairly tall, showy  
adapted to pollination by long tongued insects

**Whiskbroom parsley**  
*Harbouria tracchyleura*  
(Parsley family)

native

The very fine leaves differentiate this from similar plants. This occurs in a narrow band along the Front Range

**Meadow death camas**

*Zigadenus venenosus*  
(Lily family)

native

abundant, white torch-like  
very poisonous plant;  
Leaves closely resemble wild onion

**Evening primrose** (Evening Primrose Family)



Howard's evening primrose  
*O. howardii*



Crown-leaf evening primrose  
*O. cronopifolia*

These bloom in evening and last only until the following morning. They appear to be coming on late this year



**Stemless four nerve daisy**

*Tetaneuris acaulis*  
(Sunflower family)

native

not stemless, but stems have no leaves

(abundant below Lindenmeir lookout)
