- · Connections: Share your concerns with officials from the city and connect with other neighborhood organizations.

Madison, WI

Neighborhood Associations

- Cover most of the City
- Empower neighborhoods to work together on development proposals, policies impacting their neighborhoods

Collins

- Work with City staff to identify boundaries, bylaws, etc.
- Can apply from multiple pools of grant funding from City



Vancouver, WA

- Associations recognized by City Council
- Require neighborhood plans
- Staff liaisons for each neighborhood
- Elected leaders of associations
- Neighborhood awards program

Portland, OR



ins

- Associations recognized by City Council
 - Citizen written by-laws
 - Public Involvement
 Advisory Council
 - Neighborhood grant program
- Training programs for leaders

Los Angeles, CA



Neighborhood Councils:

- Elections
- Range from 2,000-20,000 people
- City department reps give updates at meetings
- Give grants and advertise/outreach with annual funding
- Have access to EmpowerLA staff member
- Broad representation live, work, and worship in area

Neighborhood empowerment methods:

- Annual budget of \$40k per Neighborhood Council
- Community Impact Statements for development proposals/City Council policies
- Budget Advocates participatory budgeting
- Online Leadership Academy
- Trainings offered by City technology/marketing training to CivicU
