



## Meeting Summary

**Subject:** Rossborough Park – Neighborhood Meeting  
**Date:** July 13, 2019  
**Location:** Rocky Mountain High School  
**Attendees:** Approximately 45 Neighborhood Residents

## Meeting Format

A meeting was held with neighborhood residents to present a potential pilot project to introduce a cyclo-cross skills training course at Rossborough Park.

The presentation included:

- City and project goals
- Background on the sport of cyclo-cross
- Park selection process for this pilot
- Proposed course layout and skills features
- Course marking, signage and rules of use
- Maintenance
- Pilot evaluation process
- Conditions for course closure

Following the presentation, a question and answer session was conducted. After the question and answer session, electronic polling was done to obtain information on how people use the park and the level of support from neighbors for introducing a skills training course to Rossborough Park.

## Below is a summary of the discussion:

Signage for the course: Should be thoughtful; have rules of use and course closure information at the beginning of the course; provide instructions for each feature; include “yield to pedestrians” along the course.

Course Markings: Painted lines will help park users understand where cyclists will be.

Pilot Evaluation: In early 2020 (after 1 season of use) input from neighbors, riders and city staff will be collected and reviewed to determine if the course remains as is, is modified or removed from the park.

The pilot evaluation should include discussion of the following concerns voiced by neighbors:

- Parking
- Noise levels
- Enforcement of rules of use
- Maintaining neighborhood feel
- Impacts to dog walkers
- Access to shade for existing park users
- Preserved sledding just north of the playground
- Safety of existing park users
