



## Meeting Summary

**Subject:** Rossborough Park – Neighborhood Meeting  
**Date:** February 20, 2020  
**Location:** Rocky Mountain High School

### Meeting Format

A meeting was held with neighborhood residents to give an overview of the cyclo-cross pilot project, share feedback received and offer an opportunity for neighbors to provide additional feedback. Mayor Pro Tem Kristin Stephens, Park and Recreation Board members Mary Carlson and Shari Heyman, neighbor and cyclo-cross community representative Dan Porter, and three neighborhood residents were in attendance at the meeting.

The presentation included:

- Recap of what cyclo-cross is
- Overview of the pilot skills training course and the pilot process
- What we heard from neighbors, course users, and parks maintenance staff
- Next Steps

Following the presentation, a Q & A session was conducted.

### Below is a Summary of the Discussion

The following is a list of concerns expressed by neighbors who attended the meeting:

- Potential that riders disobey rules, resulting in senior citizens and dog walkers feeling unsafe;
- Cyclists riding along the top of and over the sides of the North and East berm, which are informal pedestrian routes within the park;
- Damage to turf in the park due cyclo-cross course use;
- Limited access to shade at the Southwest corner of the park due to the cyclo-cross route;
- Why Rossborough park was selected for this use.

Staff shared that online feedback will to be collected through March 12, 2020. After March 12, feedback will be reviewed and a decision on the future of the course will be determined and shared on the project web page.
