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VENDING PARKS & TRAILS

Vending is allowed in Parks as long as the vendor has been invited by the event organizer to be a part of a sanctioned (permitted) event taking place at the Park and has a Sales Tax License. The Sales Tax License must be visibly displayed. All other vending rules and requirements must be adhered to including, but not limited to, health codes, insurance requirements, and safety.

All other vending must be done in accordance with the Outdoor Vending permit rules and regulations including, but not limited to, licensing, health codes, insurance requirements and safety.

If the vendor is not part of a sanctioned (permitted) event taking place in a park; the vendor must have an Outdoor Vending Permit and a Sales Tax License. Vending must be done in accordance with the Outdoor Vending Permit.

<u>Mobile Food Trucks</u> – May vend ONLY on lots in non-neighborhood zone districts or on streets in locations in non-neighborhood zone districts where parallel parking is allowed.

<u>Neighborhood Mobile Food Vendor</u> – May vend ONLY on street locations in neighborhood zone districts where parallel parking is allowed.

Cannot stop for more than 15 minutes in any particular cul-de-sac or on any particular block face (i.e., ice cream trucks in park parking lots)

<u>Pushcart</u> – non-motorized – May vend ONLY on lots in non-neighborhood zone districts or on streets in locations in non-neighborhood zone districts where parallel parking is allowed.

Operations & Restrictions for all Outdoor Vendors

May not be upon a public right-of-way or public street, alley or sidewalk within a City park or other City facility, recreation area, or trail without a facility-specified issue permit.
