

Colina Mariposa Natural Area

From salt meadows to rocky hillsides, this 192-acre site offers expansive views and unique habitat. A high diversity of butterflies occur on the east ridge, giving the site the name “Butterfly Hill” in Spanish. Soon, the Long View Trail will provide a link to County open space and Loveland trails to the south.

10-Year Site Management Objectives

- Protect unique hillside geologic and natural features.
- Maintain good neighborhood relations
- Improve public access to the site.
- Enhance scenic views.
