

Redtail Grove Natural Area

This 51-acre site provides a key wildlife movement corridor for Fossil Creek and contains remnants of a historic brick factory. Marine fossils from the Cretaceous Period are imbedded in shale outcrops on the site. True to its name, red-tailed hawks frequent this natural area.

10-Year Site Management Objectives

- Protect unique natural and historic features.
- Improve public access to the site.
- Provide opportunities for nature play.
- Enhance scenic views.
