

Prairie Dog Meadow Natural Area



This 84-acre site of mostly salt meadow and cattail marsh has over 160 plant species. Surrounded by development, the site provides an island of protected habitat in the urban environment. Over 80 species of birds, mammals, reptiles, and amphibians have been documented on this natural area.

10-Year Site Management Objectives

- Enhance wetland habitat.
- Continue grassland restoration.
- Provide additional trail access.
