To continue the efforts and collaboration started last year with Poudre School District, Fort Collins Police Services is monitoring the data to evaluate any disproportionate impact on any segment of PSD's population.

For example, Q1-Q2 data shows that 54% of the citations were issued to Hispanic/LatinX students. From examining the data we know:

- 7 of the citations came from 3 incidents
- All but 2 of the citations involved victims
- Citations were issued at 6 different schools
- All of the cases were initiated by PSD staff notifying SROs of the incident

We will continue to work with students, families, and staff to support a safe, equitable learning environment for all.

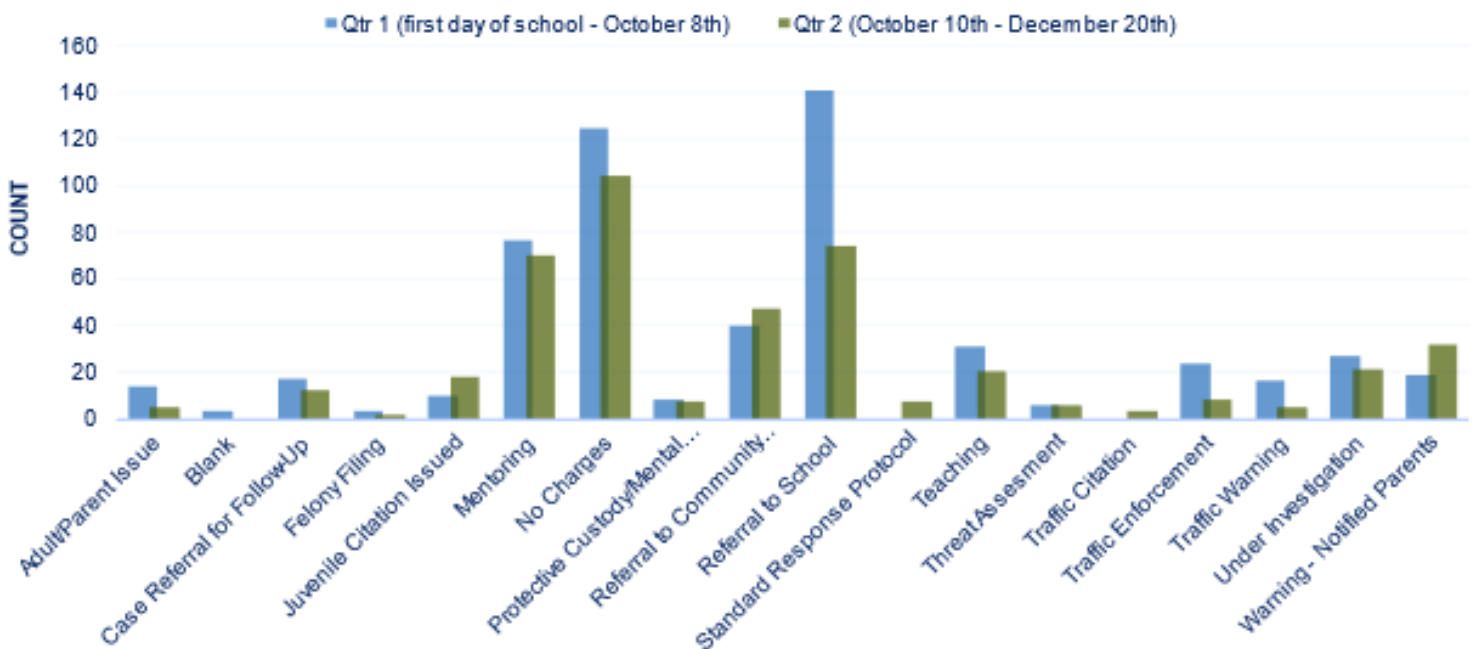

(First day of school – December 20th)

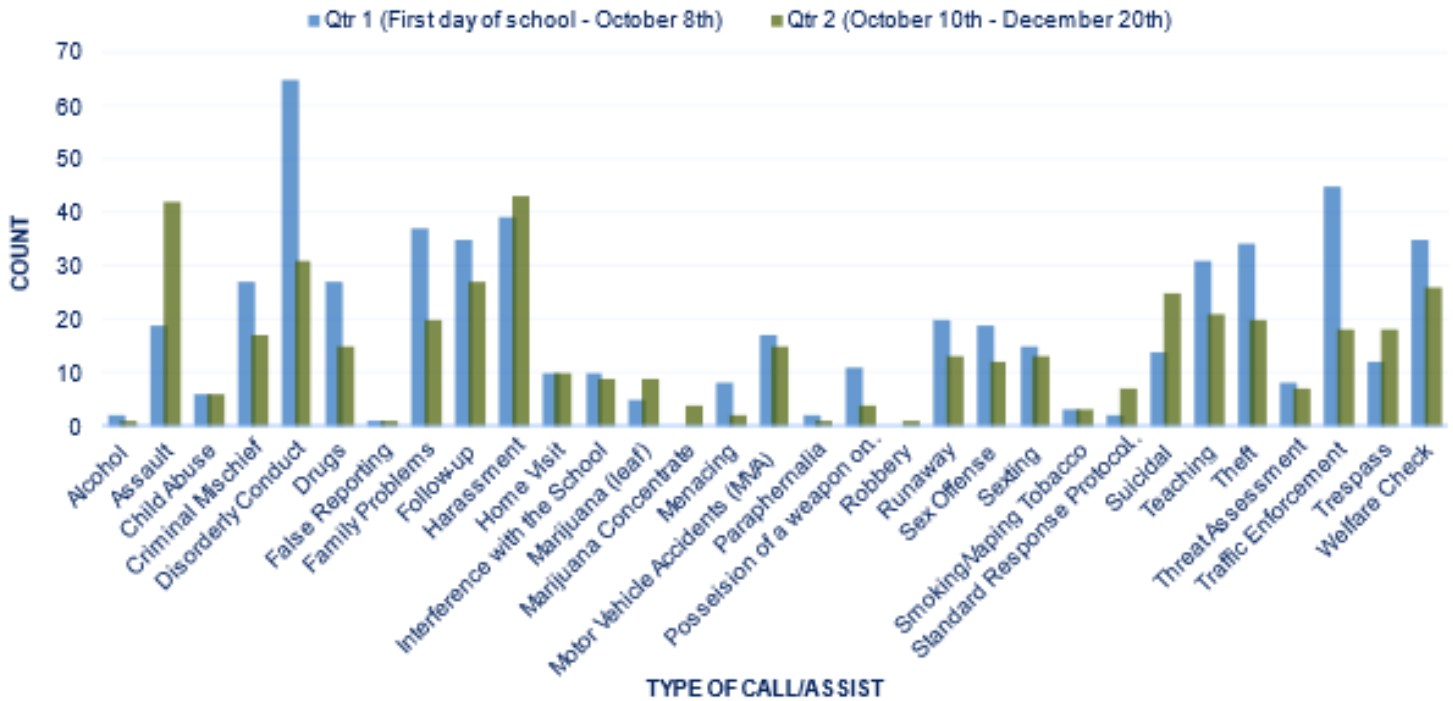
