- Equity Indicators Report Discussion
  - City employee and FC Moves Specialist Nick Heimann, who has been assisting with the equity indicators process, gave a brief overview of the study.
    - The study started in 2019 with the hiring of a consultant and has been ongoing ever since. The city is working on building a dashboard to make the data easier for people to read and understand.
    - Want to help the community understand what the data is telling us and what it's not, as well as share information on what the city is already doing.
