Mental Health Response Team	
When to Call	 First responders are needed for medical and/or safety concerns The person may or may not be open to assistance or aware that help has been called The person needs a mental health and/or basic medical assessment
Get Support	Call Fort Collins Police to request MHRT (970-419-FCPD)
Services Provided	 Crisis stabilization where the person is located. Basic mental health assessment to determine safety, risk, and need Basic medical assessment to determine if other care is needed Ongoing support until the person is stable and connected to services
Availability	 Currently Fort Collins only 7 days/week, daytime hours This team responds with police, fire, and EMS
