In accordance with the requirements of the U.S. Department of Transportation, as set forth in 49 C.F.R. Part 26, as amended, the City of Fort Collins, Colorado hereby notifies the public that it is recommending the following Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal for applicable professional services, construction and procurement contracts during Federal Fiscal Years 2021, 2022 and 2023. This goal will begin October 1, 2020 and end September 30, 2023. The overall goal for each Fiscal Year is 3%, with 2% being a race-neutral goal and 1% being a race-conscious goal.
