




How often do you play pickleball?


- A. 0-1 time per week

- D. 6 or more times per week




What level of pickleball player would you consider yourself?



Which of the following best describes the pickleball environment in Fort Collins?




Where do you play pickleball?

Level of satisfaction with Recreation's current gym schedule for drop-in pickleball?




Which rotation do you prefer?



2019 Pickleball HIGHLIGHTS & Next Steps

- Spring Canyon Community Park added 12 courts within the tennis courts
- City Park courts had annual maintenance completed in the summer of 2019
- Open gym time at the Senior Center being reduced to accommodate more pickleball time
- To allow participation in underrepresented activities, Open gym schedule policy prohibiting net sports will remain in place
- Pickleball will continue to follow the model of other recreation activities. Pickleball drop-in time will be open to all skill levels and Pickleball P.O.P. times will have sessions devoted to specific user groups
- Fort Collins Recreation multi-facility pass holders and SilverSneakers pass holders will continue to receive 70% off Pickleball P.O.P. programming
