# Starting January 1, 2023

L	Charge 10 cents for each paper and plastic bag* used at checkouts and for pickup and
	delivery orders (excludes retail food establishments)
	Display the number of paper and plastic bags and the amount charged on each receipt
	Report the total amount of fees collected in the first quarter
	Remit paper bag fee revenue to the City of Fort Collins for all bag fees collected to date
	(60% of total bag fee revenue) by the end O2 2023.

### Starting January 1, 2024

☐ Remove plastic bags and continue charging 10 cents for every paper bag used at checkout and for pickup and delivery orders\*\*

## Starting June 1, 2024

☐ Stores can no longer provide plastic bags. Inventory purchased **before January 1, 2024,** can no longer be used.

<sup>\*\*</sup> Stores can continue to provide plastic bags purchased before January 1, 2024, with the 10-cent fee until June 1, 2024.





<sup>\*</sup>Grocery stores included in the Disposable Bag Ordinance must continue to follow the plastic bag ban.
