#### Starting January 1, 2023

- Charge 10 cents for each paper and plastic bag\* used at checkouts and for pickup and delivery orders (excludes retail food establishments)
- lacksquare Display the number of paper and plastic bags and the amount charged on each receipt
- igsquare Report the total amount of fees collected in the first quarter
- □ Remit paper bag fee revenue to the City of Fort Collins for all bag fees collected to date (60% of total bag fee revenue) by the end Q2 2023.

## <u>Starting January 1, 2024</u>

Remove plastic bags and continue charging 10 cents for every paper bag used at checkout and for pickup and delivery orders\*\*

# <u>Starting June 1, 2024</u>

Stores can no longer provide plastic bags. Inventory purchased **before January 1, 2024**, can no longer be used.

\*Grocery stores included in the Disposable Bag Ordinance must continue to follow the plastic bag ban. \*\* Stores can continue to provide plastic bags purchased before January 1, 2024, with the 10-cent fee until June 1, 2024.
