## Here's how to recycle right!

### CARDBOARD: Not for the trash



#### Recycle:

Put flattened cardboard in your complex's recycling dumpster or take it to the **Timberline Recycling Center**, 1903 S. Timberline Rd.

#### Reuse

Post moving boxes on Craigslist, Next Door or Facebook Marketplace.



### WHAT TO RECYCLE

#### KEEP OUT:

- Plastic Bags
- Batteries
- Needles
- Food
- Liquids
- Paper Coffee Cups



- Plastic Utensils
- Straws
- Paper Plates
- Napkins



### HOW TO RECYCLE

- Place recyclables loose in the bin.
- Trash any plastic bags you use to transport recyclables – they shouldn't go into recycling dumpsters.



### WHERE TO RECYCLE

- Recycle in recycling dumpsters at your complex
- Recycle at the **Timberline Recycling Center**, 1903 S. Timberline Rd.
  - **Everyday Recyclables Yard:** (cans, bottles, newspapers, cardboard and plastic bags) Open seven days a week during daylight hours.
  - **Hard-to-Recycle Yard:** (batteries, metal, electronics) \$5 entry fee. Open Tuesday through Saturday. Additional charges apply for certain items.

### KEEP BULKY ITEMS OUT

- Keep trash, furniture and bulky items out of recycling and recycling dumpsters. They are only intended for everyday waste.

### RECYCLE MATTRESSES

For a fee, recycle bedbug-free mattresses with **Spring Back Colorado**. Pick up or drop-off available.
