Dear Trash or Recyclables Hauler,

It's time to renew licenses for 2019. Enclosed is the 2019 Solid Waste Hauler License Application (which now is combined with the Solid Waste Rates and Recycling Plan).

Please note that all forms, including Tonnage Reporting forms for the previous year, must be complete and accurate in order to renew your license. For your convenience, these forms can also be downloaded as fillable PDFs from fcgov.com/recycling/forms.

In order to receive your 2019 license, the following materials must be submitted:

- Solid Waste Collectors License Application
- Valid Certificate of Insurance
- License Fee
