Effective November 1, 2020 the City of Fort Collins will adopt a new sales tax ordinance for Economic Nexus and Marketplace Facilitators.

Who is regulated by this ordinance?

This ordinance applies to businesses that meet the definition of economic nexus, marketplace facilitators, multichannel sellers, and marketplace sellers. These definitions can be found in the new ordinance linked above.

Where Can Remote Vendors File Sales Tax for the City of Fort Collins?

The City of Fort Collins will allow remote vendors to file their 3.85% Fort Collins sales tax through the State of Colorado's Sales and Use Tax System (SUTS). The SUTS system will link your Colorado tax license to your Fort Collins license number to satisfy filing requirements. SUTS allows businesses to find applicable sales and use taxes, as well as credits and deductions, associated with a specific destination and file a single remittance that will then go to multiple jurisdictions.
