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## Sales and Use Tax Collection Report – January 2018

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This report reflects Sales and Use Tax collected in January 2018 for economic activity that occurred in December 2017. Please note the sales and use tax collected in January 2018 is predominately from December 2017 sales but also includes delinquent collections from prior periods.

Figure 1. Budget to Actual - Sales and Use Tax Collected Excluding Rebates




Figure 2. Sales and Use Tax Collected		January		<b>\</b>	ear to Date

**January Sales Tax Collected.** In January 2018, sales tax collected in Fort Collins increased 5.1% compared to January 2017. Sales tax collected totaled \$12.1M compared to \$11.5M in 2017.

**January Use Tax Collected.** The total use tax collected in January was \$2.0M, a decrease of 28.9% compared to last January. The estimated use tax collected in January related to economic incentive agreements was \$0 as illustrated on Figure 2. The net use tax collections for January totaled \$2.0M for a net 28.6% decrease.

**Sales and Use Tax Collected Excluding Rebates.** Total tax collected of \$14.0M was 1.4% lower than January 2017.

**January Sales Tax Budget to Actual.** In January 2018, sales tax collected in Fort Collins was \$270K more than the budget.


**January Use Tax Budget to Actual Excluding Rebates.** In January 2018, use tax collected in Fort Collins was \$123K more than the budget.

At the national level, December 2017 retail sales (as reported on January 12, 2018) increased by 5.4% compared to an increase in Fort Collins' sales of 5.9%. December 2017 sales are the basis for the City's January 2018 sales tax collections and net taxable amounts (which are included in this report).

Figure 10. January - Net Taxable Sales Subject to Sales Tax





Figure 11. Year to Date - Net Taxable Sales Subject to Sales Tax

The City's sales tax rate of 3.85% can be broken into two pieces:

- 2.25% comprises the Core Base rate and supports general fund activities
- 1.6% comprises the Dedicated Base and goes to four specific funds to support activities defined in the ballot language for that dedicated tax.

The Foothills Mall agreement outlines a base year of May 2012 to April 2013 to determine the core base sales tax (2.25%) received at \$1.8M. Anything remitted to the City above that core base amount will be returned to the Metro District to support debt service. No tax is remitted to the Metro District until the base of \$1.8M is reached. The chart above tracks both Core and Dedicated tax receipts for the period of May to April. As of January 31, 2018, the core amount collected is \$1,647K.

**Sales Tax in the City's Downtown Area.** The sales tax collected in January for the downtown area increased 6.3% from the same period in 2017.

**Lodging Tax Collections.** The City collected \$101K in lodging taxes in January 2018. This was an increase of 23.7% from January 2017.

Sales Tax Licenses. There were 12,244 active sales tax licenses at the end of January.
