This report reflects Sales and Use Tax collected in June for economic activity that occurred in May. Please note the sales and use tax collected in June is predominately from May sales but also includes delinquent collections from prior periods.

Figure 1. Budget to Actual - Sales and Use Tax Collected After Rebates

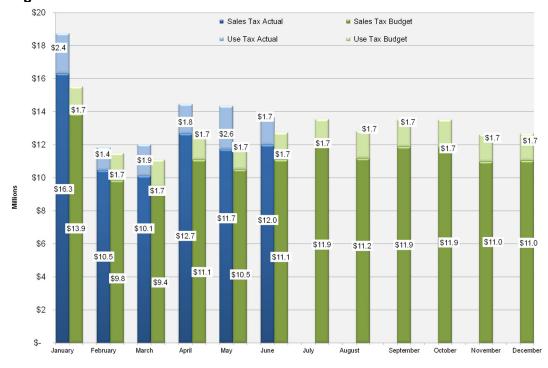


Figure 2. Sales and Use Tax Collected		June		Y	ear to Date

NET SALES & USE TAX

**June Sales Tax Collected.** In June 2022, sales tax collected in Fort Collins increased 9.3% compared to June 2021. Sales tax collected totaled \$12.0M compared to \$11.0M in 2021.

**June Use Tax Collected.** The total use tax collected in June was \$1.7M, a decrease of 6.8% compared to June 2021.

**Net Sales and Use Tax Collected.** Total tax collected of \$13.7M was 7.1% higher than June 2021.

Figure 5. Budget to Actual – Sales and Use Tax Distribution

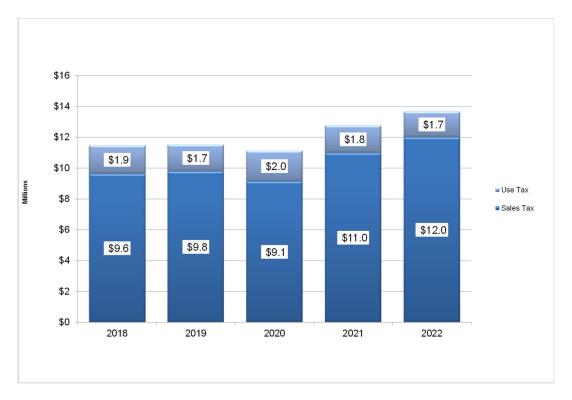

**June Sales Tax Budget to Actual.** In June 2022, sales tax collected in Fort Collins was \$906k more than budget.

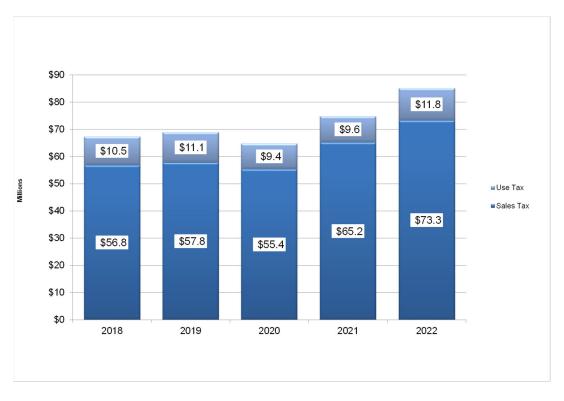
**June Use Tax Budget to Actual Excluding Rebates.** In June 2022, use tax collected in Fort Collins was \$23K more than budget.

At the national level, May 2022 retail sales (as reported on June 15, 2022) increased by 8.1% compared to an increase in Fort Collins' sales of 9.5%. May 2022 sales are the basis for the City's June 2022 sales tax collections and net taxable amounts (which are included in this report).

Figure 10. June - Net Taxable Sales Subject to Sales Tax

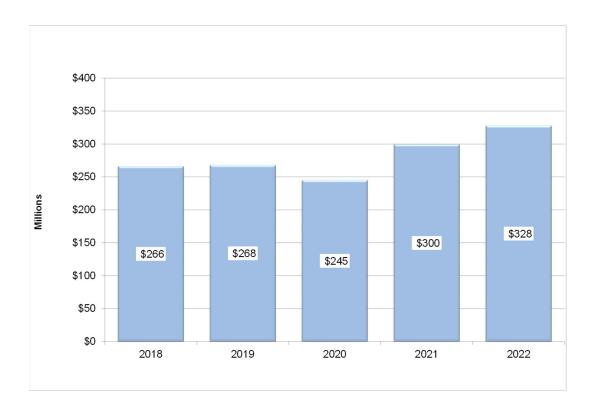


Figure 11. Year to Date - Net Taxable Sales Subject to Sales Tax

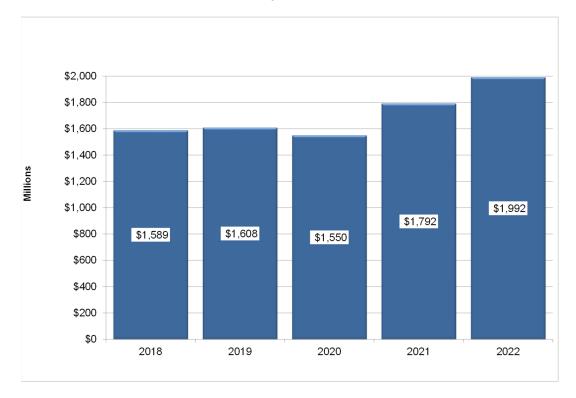
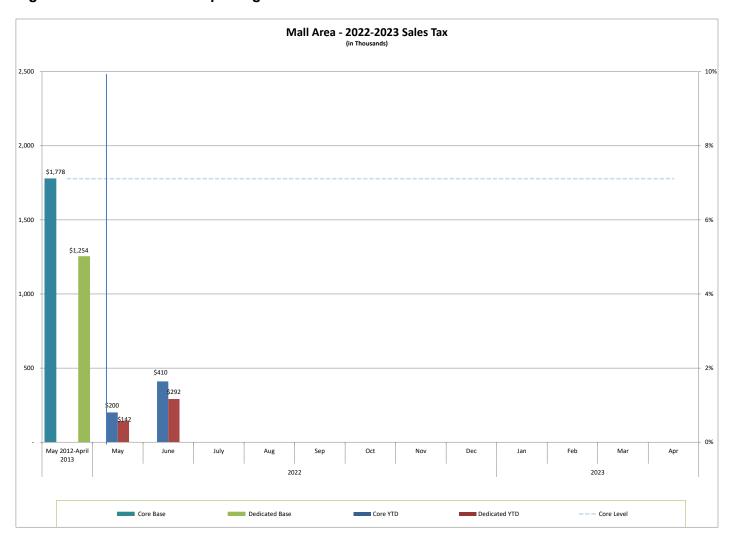


Figure 12. Metro District Reporting



The Foothills Mall agreement outlines a base year of May 2012 to April 2013 to determine the core base sales tax (2.25%) received at \$1.8M. Anything remitted to the City above that core base amount will be returned to the Metro District to support debt service. No tax is remitted to the Metro District until the base of \$1.8M is reached. The chart above tracks both Core and Dedicated tax receipts for the period of May to April. As of June 2022, the year to date core amount collected is \$410K resulting in no tax due to the Metro District.

**Sales Tax in the City's Downtown Area.** The sales tax collected in June for the downtown area increased 10.3% from the same period in 2021.

**Lodging Tax Collections.** The City collected \$186K in lodging tax in June 2022. This was an increase of 70.8% from June 2021.

Sales Tax Licenses. There were 14,728 active sales tax licenses at the end of June.
