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Sales and Use Tax Collection Report - May 2023

Issued June 12, 2023

This report reflects Sales and Use Tax collected in May for economic activity that occurred in April. Please note the sales and use tax collected in May is predominately from April sales but also includes delinquent collections from prior periods.

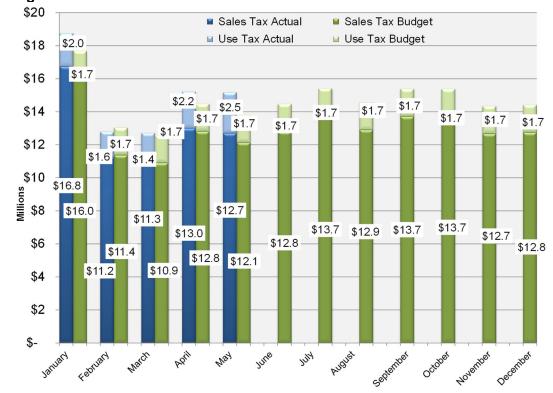
Year to date, sales and use tax collections excluding rebates are up 4.5% and total \$74.7M.

NET SALES & USE TAX

May Sales Tax Collected. In May 2023, sales tax collected in Fort Collins increased 8.3% compared to May 2022. Sales tax collected totaled \$12.7M compared to \$11.7M in 2022.

May Use Tax Collected. The total use tax collected in May was \$2.5M, a decrease of 5.8% compared to May 2022.

Net Sales and Use Tax Collected. Total tax collected of \$15.2M was 5.7% higher than May 2022.

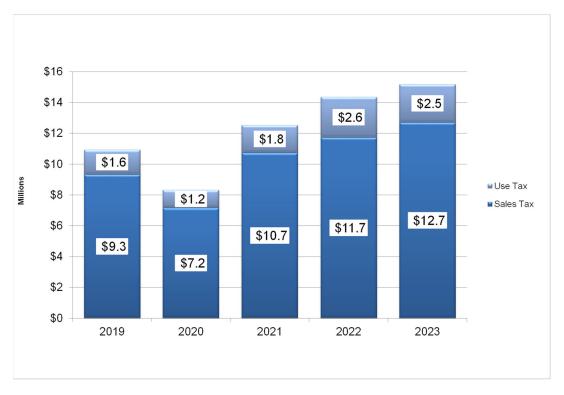

May Sales Tax Budget to Actual. In May 2023, sales tax collected in Fort Collins was \$576K more than budget.

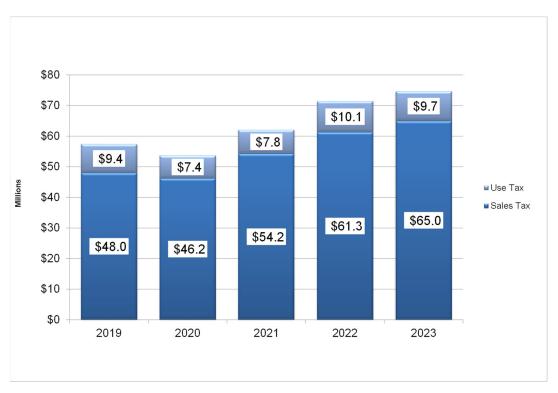
May Use Tax Budget to Actual Excluding Rebates. In May 2023, use tax collected in Fort Collins was \$804K more than budget.

At the national level, April 2023 retail sales (as reported on May 16, 2023) increased by 1.6% compared to an increase in Fort Collins' sales of 3.6%. April 2023 sales are the basis for the City's May 2023 sales tax collections and net taxable amounts (which are included in this report).

Figure 10. May - Net Taxable Sales Subject to Sales Tax

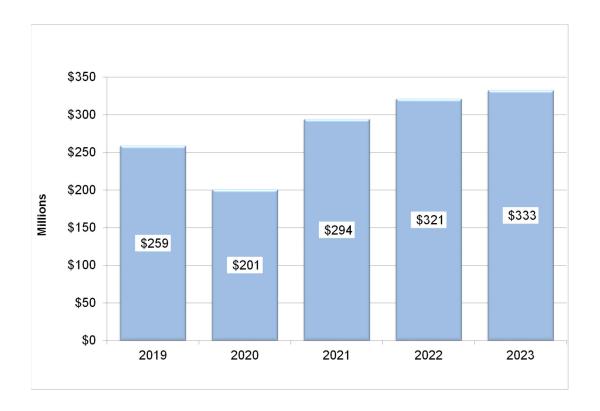


Figure 11. Year to Date - Net Taxable Sales Subject to Sales Tax

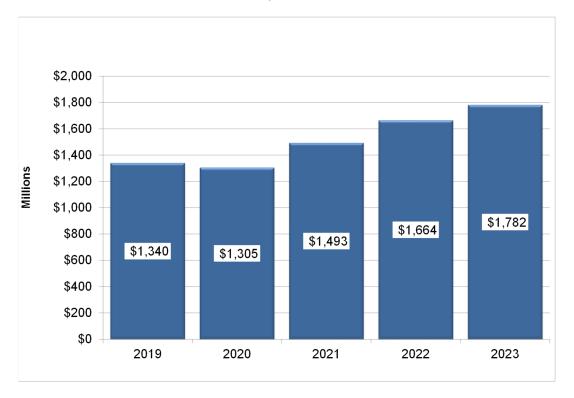
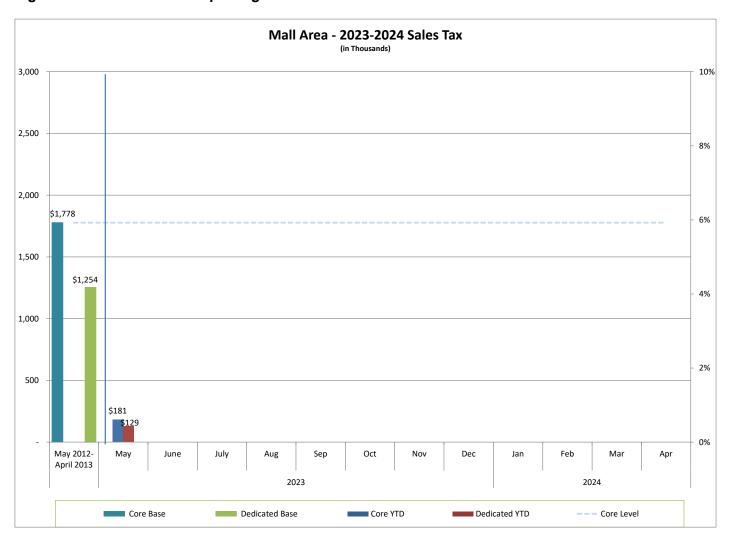


Figure 12. Metro District Reporting



The Foothills Mall agreement outlines a base year of May 2012 to April 2013 to determine the core base sales tax (2.25%) received at \$1.8M. Anything remitted to the City above that core base amount will be returned to the Metro District to support debt service. No tax is remitted to the Metro District until the base of \$1.8M is reached. The chart above tracks both Core and Dedicated tax receipts for the period of May to April. As of May 2023, the year to date core amount collected is \$181K resulting in no tax due to the Metro District.

Sales Tax in the City's Downtown Area. The sales tax collected in May for the downtown area decreased 7.1% from the same period in 2022.

Lodging Tax Collections. The City collected \$144K in lodging tax in May 2023. This was an increase of 6.5% from May 2022.

Sales Tax Licenses. There were 13,253 active sales tax licenses at the end of May.
