This report reflects Sales and Use Tax collected in November for economic activity that occurred in October. Please note the sales and use tax collected in November is predominately from October sales but also includes delinquent collections from prior periods.

Figure 1. Budget to Actual - Sales and Use Tax Collected After Rebates

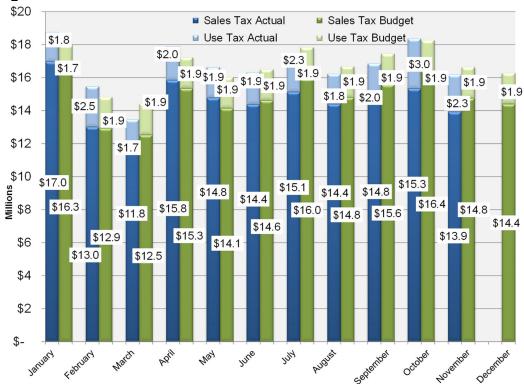


Figure 2. Sales and Use Tax Collected		November		Y

November Sales Tax Collected. In November 2024, sales tax collected in Fort Collins increased 13.0% compared to November 2023. Sales tax collected totaled \$13.9M compared to \$12.3M in 2023.

November Use Tax Collected. The total use tax collected in November was \$2.3M, an increase of 6.8% compared to November 2023.

Net Sales and Use Tax Collected. Total tax collected of \$16.2M was 12.1% more than November 2023.

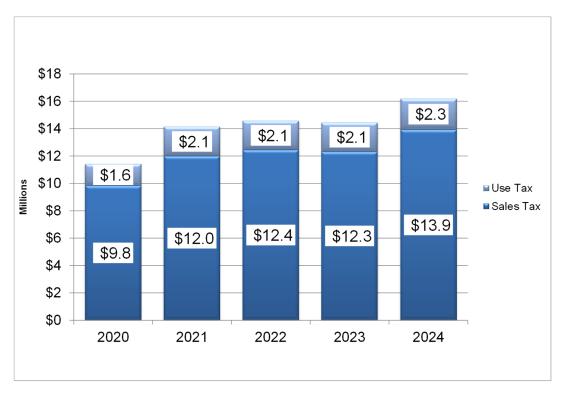

At the national level, October 2024 retail sales (as reported on November 15, 2024) increased by 2.8% compared to an increase in Fort Collins' sales of 1.8%. October 2024 sales are the basis for the City's November 2024 sales tax collections and net taxable amounts (which are included in this report).

Figure 10. November - Net Taxable Sales Subject to Sales Tax

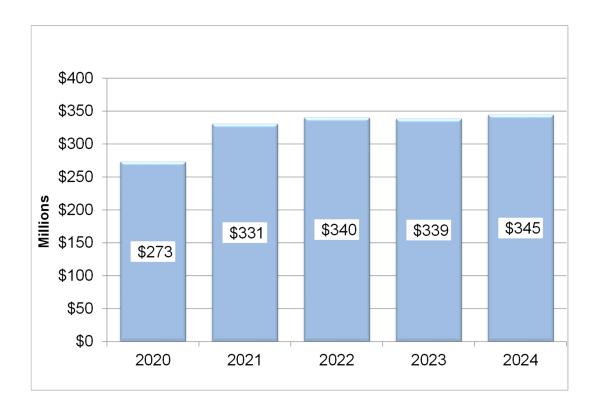


Figure 11. Year to Date - Net Taxable Sales Subject to Sales Tax

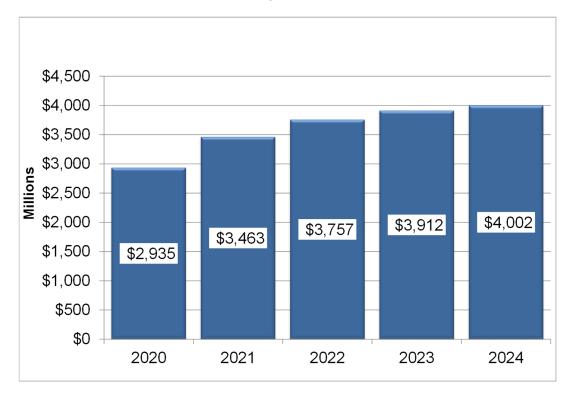
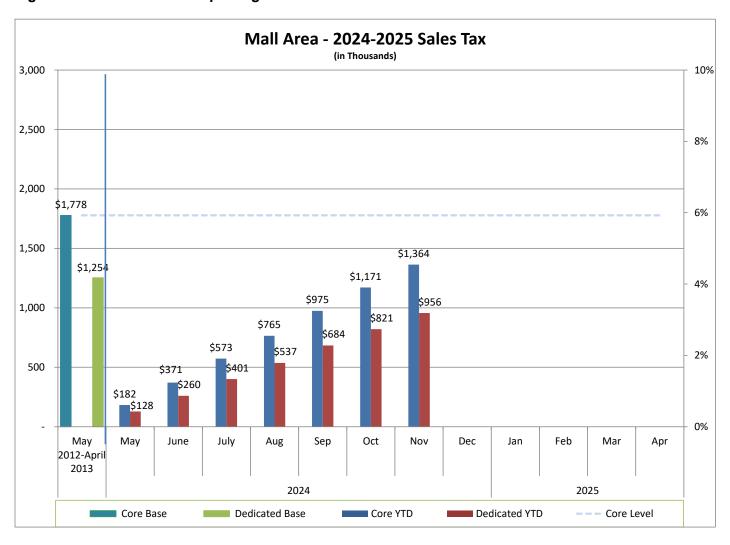


Figure 12. Metro District Reporting



The Foothills Mall agreement outlines a base year of May 2012 to April 2013 to determine the core base sales tax (2.25%) received at \$1.8M. Anything remitted to the City above that core base amount will be returned to the Metro District to support debt service. No tax is remitted to the Metro District until the base of \$1.8M is reached. The chart above tracks both Core and Dedicated tax receipts for the period of May to April. As of November 2024, the year-to-date core amount collected is \$1.4M resulting in no tax due to the Metro District.

Sales Tax in the City's Downtown Area. The sales tax collected in November for the downtown area increased 9.4% from the same period in 2023.

Lodging Tax Collections. The City collected \$227K in lodging tax in November 2024. This was a decrease of 1.5% from November 2023.

Sales Tax Licenses. There were 13,930 active sales tax licenses at the end of November.
