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Sales and Use Tax Collection Report - April 2025

Issued May 12, 2025

This report reflects Sales and Use Tax collected in April for economic activity that occurred in March. Please note the sales and use tax collected in April is predominately from March sales but also includes delinquent collections from prior periods.

Figure 1. Budget to Actual - Sales and Use Tax Collected After Rebate




Figure 2. Sales and Use Tax Collected		April		Y	Year to Date

April Sales Tax Collected. In April 2025, sales tax collected in Fort Collins decreased 3.1% compared to April 2024. Sales tax collected totaled \$15.4M compared to \$15.8M in 2024.

April Use Tax Collected. The total use tax collected in April was \$2.4M, an increase of 15.2% compared to April 2024.

Net Sales and Use Tax Collected. Total tax collected of \$17.7M was 1.0% lower than April 2024.


Figure 5. Budget to Actual – Sales and Use Tax Distribution

April Sales Tax Budget to Actual. In April 2025, sales tax collected in Fort Collins was \$643K less than budget.


April Use Tax Budget to Actual Excluding Rebates. In April 2025, use tax collected in Fort Collins was \$275K more than budget.

At the national level, March 2025 retail sales (as reported on April 16, 2025) increased by 4.6% compared to a decrease in Fort Collins' sales of 3.8%. March 2025 sales are the basis for the City's April 2025 sales tax collections and net taxable amounts (which are included in this report).

Figure 10. April - Net Taxable Sales Subject to Sales Tax




Figure 11. Year to Date - Net Taxable Sales Subject to Sales Tax





Figure 12. Metro District Reporting



The Foothills Mall agreement outlines a base year of May 2012 to April 2013 to determine the core base sales tax (2.25%) received at \$1.8M. Anything remitted to the City above that core base amount will be returned to the Metro District to support debt service. No tax is remitted to the Metro District until the base of \$1.8M is reached. The chart above tracks both Core and Dedicated tax receipts for the period of May to April. As of April 2025, the year to date core amount collected is \$2.3M resulting in \$506K tax due to the Metro District.

Sales Tax in the City's Downtown Area. The sales tax collected in April for the downtown area decreased 3.5% from the same period in 2024.

Lodging Tax Collections. The City collected \$163K in lodging tax in April 2025. This was a decrease of 5.5% from April 2024.

Sales Tax Licenses. There were 13,764 active sales tax licences at the end of April.
