
Year to date, sales and use tax collections excluding rebates are up 5.6% and total \$157.5M.

**NET SALES & USE TAX** 

**September Sales Tax Collected.** In September 2025, sales tax collected in Fort Collins increased 3.4% compared to September 2024. Sales tax collected totaled \$15.3M compared to \$14.8M in 2024.

**September Use Tax Collected.** The total use tax collected in September was \$1.2M, a decrease of 42.9% compared to September 2024.

Net Sales and Use Tax Collected. Total tax collected of \$16.5M was 2.2% lower than September 2024.

Figure 5. Budget to Actual – Sales and Use Tax Distribution



**September Sales Tax Budget to Actual.** In September 2025, sales tax collected in Fort Collins was \$340K less than budget.


**September Use Tax Budget to Actual Excluding Rebates.** In September 2025, use tax collected in Fort Collins was \$918K less than budget.

At the national level, August 2025 retail sales (as reported on September 16, 2025) increased by 5.0% compared to an increase in Fort Collins' sales of 3.6%. August 2025 sales are the basis for the City's September 2025 sales tax collections and net taxable amounts (which are included in this report).

Figure 10. September - Net Taxable Sales Subject to Sales Tax




Figure 11. Year to Date - Net Taxable Sales Subject to Sales Tax





Figure 12. Metro District Reporting



The Foothills Mall agreement outlines a base year of May 2012 to April 2013 to determine the core base sales tax (2.25%) received at \$1.8M. Anything remitted to the City above that core base amount will be returned to the Metro District to support debt service. No tax is remitted to the Metro District until the base of \$1.8M is reached. The chart above tracks both Core and Dedicated tax receipts for the period of May to April. As of September 2025, the year-to-date core amount collected is \$904K resulting in no tax due to the Metro District.

**Sales Tax in the City's Downtown Area.** The sales tax collected in September for the downtown area increased 1.8% from the same period in 2024.

**Lodging Tax Collections.** The City collected \$266K in lodging tax in September 2025. This was an increase of 1.1% from September 2024.

Sales Tax Licenses. There were 14,097 active sales tax licenses at the end of September.
