- Shower and Laundry Lottery at the Murphy Center Front Door at 9 am
- Submit name for FCRM Shelter Lottery at Front Desk 8 am 2 pm
- Reserve at check-in: access to Resource Navigation services, Computers, Phones, Access to Digital Offices and Appointments with On-site Agencies: Summitstone Health Partners, Homeward Alliance (Hand Up Employment, Peer Recovery, Re-Entry, etc.), VA, VOA, Catholic Charities Senior Program, Street Dog Coalition, etc.

- Shelter Lottery will be conducted beginning at 3 pm at the Murphy Center, 242 Conifer Street, Fort Collins. Submit your name for the lottery between 8 am and 2 pm at the Murphy Center Front Desk.
- Those not selected for the shelter lottery, or those who chose not to participate, will be provided with a meal bag (dinner the same day and lunch for the next day).
- Please note: those who are banned from the Murphy Center may participate in the lottery and/or receive a meal bag by calling or visiting FCRM and making alternative arrangements.

Shelter Details (please check directly with FCRM for a full list of shelter rules and policies):

- Overflow guests will be awoken at 6:30 am
- Any guests in an overflow BED will automatically have their name recorded for that bed for the following evening. A failure to utilize that bed in the evening will result in their name removed from that bed.
- Hot breakfast will be served at 7 am. Overflow guests are asked to leave by 7:45 am.
- Guests who used BEDS (not Mats) will have the option to stay at the FCRM shelter during the day (as long as shelter rules are followed).
- Evening check-in will begin at 5:00 pm at the west door on Linden Street. Only verified lottery chosen guests are admitted.
- Dinner service will begin at 5:30 pm
- Quiet time in dorms at 8 pm. Lights out in dorms at 10 pm

Extended Stay Program

- Extended stay beds available for men (18), women (6), families (4 dedicated rooms) and veterans (12).
- Access to the program is through an application process
- Entry time is 4pm for families and 5pm for individuals
- For men and women dinner is served at 6pm, lights out at 10pm, wake up and breakfast is 7am and daily exit takes place at 8:30am.
- For families dinner is served at 6pm, lights out at 9pm, wake up and breakfast is 7am and daily exit takes place at 8:30am.
- All meals are provided as well as case management and access to restrooms/showers and laundry facilities
- Duration for the program varies by the unique needs of each program participant
- Day shelter is provided on weekend days
- This is a sober living program

Emergency Shelter Program

- Emergency overflow beds available for women (54) and families
- Entry time for families begin at 4pm and women at 5pm
- Women utilize outdoor warming shelter starting with entry and dinner starting at 7pm.
- For women dinner is served at 6:30pm, lights out at 9pm, wake up and breakfast is 6:15am and daily exit takes place at 8:00am.
- For families dinner is served at 6pm, lights out at 9pm, wake up and breakfast is 7am and daily exit takes place at 8:30am.
- All meals are provided
- Clean linens provided nightly
