

Extreme Heat Response in Fort Collins

Upon identification from the National Weather Service (NWS) that a day is entering an "orange" or "red" level of heat, homeless service providers in the community will be notified to take respective action.

- **Orange - Moderate Heat Risk:**
 - Partners will spread the word about the increased heat risk and encourage people experiencing homelessness to seek shade and/or indoor shelter, stay hydrated, and wear sunscreen (water and sunscreen to be distributed).
- **Red - Major Heat Risk Declared:**
 - The Murphy Center will be open extended hours.
 - Partners will spread the word about the increased heat risk and encourage people to seek shade and/or indoor shelter, stay hydrated, and wear sunscreen (water and sunscreen to be distributed).
