Tips

- Teams of 2 or 3 people can cover both sides of one mile of roadway in a couple of hours.
- The City will provide gloves, safety vests, trash bags and a supply bin.
- The City will schedule a pick-up of bagged litter collected by volunteers; typically the next working day.

Program Background

Since 1987, volunteer throughout Colorado have “adopted” and cared for hundreds of miles of streets and highways. The City of Fort Collins Streets Department has a program that enables organizations to adopt a segment of a city street.

How the Program Works

Your organization will receive a designated stretch of road at least one mile long. It will be the group’s responsibility to pick up litter along the street a minimum of 3 times per year (dates are of your choosing). Group participants must sign a release form prior to clean-up. The City will install a sign at each end of the designated after the group performs 3 clean-ups.
