The City of Fort Collins has <u>ACTIVATED</u> the **Emergency Weather Shelter Plan**

April 10, 2019 (Wednesday Night)

The plan will be in operation April 10, 2019 (Wednesday night) due to a Winter Storm Warning and Blizzard Warning issued by the National Weather Service. The City of Fort Collins is in communication with both internal City departments and external community partners to coordinate additional overnight shelter space, warming centers and transportation.

Anyone seeking overnight shelter should go to Catholic Charities, 460 Linden Center Drive at 9:00pm for women (at Community of Christ Church) and 10:00pm for men (at Catholic Charities), or Fort Collins Rescue Mission, 316 Jefferson Street at 5:30pm

During emergency weather activation, additional options for overnight shelter are secured and community resources maximized to support those seeking shelter.

Individuals who are looking for temporary shelter are welcome.

Day shelter will be provided as usual – mornings (8am - 11:30 am) at the Murphy Center and afternoons (12 - 4pm) at Catholic Charities.

Transfort will provide transportation between the shelter sites and warming centers.
