

The City of Fort Collins has activated the Emergency Weather Shelter Plan for November 25, 2019 (Monday night) and November 26, 2019 (Tuesday night).

The plan will be in operation **November 25-26, 2019 (Monday and Tuesday nights) due to a Winter Storm Warning issued by the National Weather Service and forecasted temperatures close to or below zero degrees.**

The City of Fort Collins is in communication with both internal City departments and external community partners to coordinate additional overnight shelter space, warming centers and transportation. **Anyone seeking overnight shelter should go to Catholic Charities, 460 Linden Center Dr., at 9:00 p.m. for men, Community of Christ Church (220 E. Oak St.) for women, or Fort Collins Rescue Mission, 316 Jefferson St., at 5:30 for men and women.**

During emergency weather activation, additional options for overnight shelter are secured and community resources maximized to support those seeking shelter.

Additionally, warming centers are provided in the community. The following warming centers will be available:

Monday thru Friday 5-10pm – Murphy Center – 242 Conifer Street

Saturdays, 5-10pm – Fort Collins Mennonite Fellowship, 300 E. Oak Street

Sundays, 6-10pm – PEAK Community Church, 500 Mathews St.

Individuals who are looking for temporary shelter are welcome.

Additionally, the Murphy Center is open M-F 8am-11:30am and Catholic Charities noon-4pm for day shelter.

The City will provide transportation between the shelter sites and warming centers.
