February 6-7, 2019 (Wednesday and Thursday Nights)

The plan will be in operation <u>WEDNESDAY Night</u>, <u>February 6, 2019 and THURSDAY Night</u> <u>February 7, 2019</u> due to forecasted low temperatures close to or below 0 degrees Fahrenheit.

The City of Fort Collins is in communication with both internal City departments and external community partners to coordinate additional overnight shelter space, warming centers and transportation.

Anyone seeking overnight shelter should go to

During emergency weather activation, additional options for overnight shelter are secured and community resources maximized to support those seeking shelter.

Day shelter will be provided as usual – mornings (8am – 11:30 am) at the Murphy Center and afternoons (12 – 4pm) at Catholic Charities.

Transfort will provide transportation between the shelter sites and warming centers.
