



## PROCLAMATION

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of Transportation's National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, Federal Highway Administration, and Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration have joined forces with the National Safety Council to launch the *Road to Zero* coalition with the goal of ending fatalities on the nation's roads within the next 30 years; and

**WHEREAS**, the Colorado Department of Transportation has established the *Moving Towards Zero Deaths* Initiative to promote a vision of zero traffic-related fatalities and serious injuries; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fort Collins shares the national and state commitment to roadway safety for all users; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's Traffic Operations Department, in partnership with Police Services, collects, compiles, analyzes, reports, utilizes and monitors crash data to support safety; and

**WHEREAS**, the number of serious injury crashes in the city has decreased in each of the last three years (from 294 to 240); and

**WHEREAS**, the City actively administers programs, conducts community outreach, and implements projects related to numerous emphasis areas of the State's Strategic Highway Safety Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the City further supports safety through planning, education engineering, construction, operation, maintenance, programming, and enforcement activities.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Wade Troxell, Mayor of the City of Fort Collins, do hereby proclaim the City of Fort Collins as a community committed to *Moving Towards Zero Deaths* and partnering with the Colorado Department of Transportation in its *Moving Towards Zero Deaths* Initiative through the State's Strategic Highway Safety Plan.
