

I-25 Crossroads Bridge Replacement Project



1. PROJECT OVERVIEW

The project includes:

- The northbound and southbound bridges that carry I-25 over Crossroads Boulevard will be replaced.
- Approximately 1.5 miles of the existing roadway of I-25 will be reconstructed with new wider pavement, shoulders, improved roadway grades and roadside safety.
- New 28 foot shoulders on I-25 will allow for a future express lane.
- The new bridges over I-25 will accommodate a wider cross section on, before, and after the Crossroads Boulevard roundabout.
- Widening Crossroads Boulevard to two-lanes in each direction under I-25.
- A 0.67 mile extension of Byrd Drive will be constructed to connect with Goldco Drive. This will include two 7-foot bike lanes, two 6-foot tree lawns, and two 6-foot sidewalks.

2. FUNDING

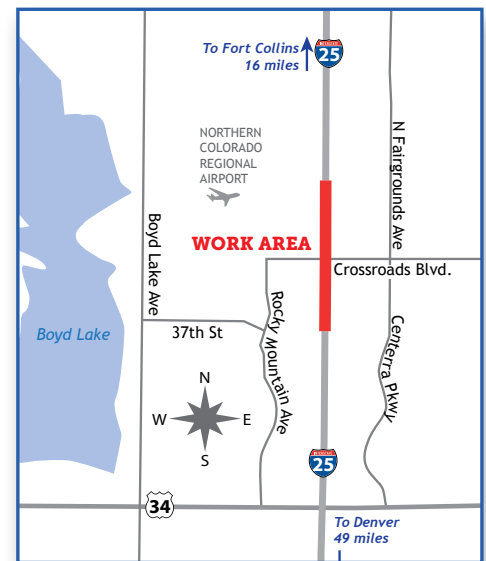
- Majority of \$22.1 million project funded by RAMP and the North Front Range Metropolitan Planning Organization.

3. PROJECT BENEFITS

- Replacement of bridge provides a safer, smoother roadway for the traveling public.
- New, wider 28 foot shoulder will allow for the future express lane to alleviate congestion on I-25.
- Extension of Byrd Drive will provide wider driving lanes and safer pedestrian access.
- Wider cross section of Crossroads Boulevard will improve roadway geometry and channeling will improve safety and driver expectations.

4. PROJECT DURATION AND TIMES

- Duration: September 2016 - November 2017
- Normal working hours will be Monday through Friday 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. However, there are key work elements that will need to occur at night or on weekends in order to reduce impacts to the traveling public.



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
