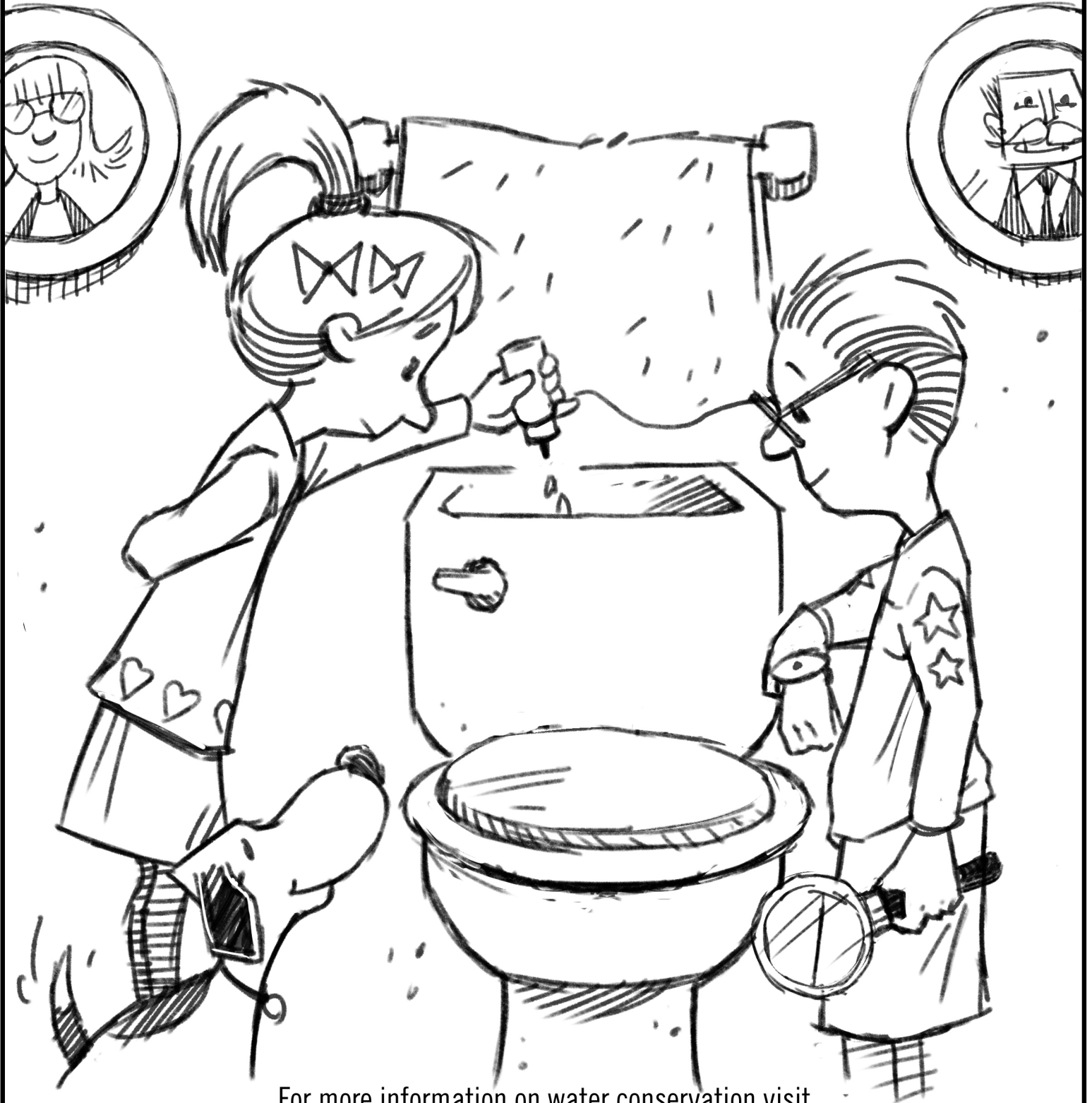
Take shorter showers – try for 5 minutes or less!
