Step 2: Attend one free Epic Homes training annually.

Step 3: Enroll.

After completing the Epic Homes training, you will receive enrollment forms and be eligible to join the network.

You are required to provide your current Colorado Real Estate Agency license number or certification number appropriate to your field.

Step 4: Maintain your Network status.

To maintain your status, participate annually in an Epic Homes training and use the Real Estate Ally Network toolkit accurately and regularly in your own marketing throughout the year.

STEP 3: Agreement to insurance requirements

Epic Homes Real Estate Allies are required to hold liability insurance with minimum limits of \$1,000,000.00 combined single limit for each occurrence. Provide a copy of Certificate of Professional Liability Insurance.

STEP 4: Submittal Instructions

Please scan a copy of the signed application and email it, along with all required documentation, to Epic Homes, epichomes@fcgov.com. Please note that email is the preferred method for submitting forms.

What to expect next:

If you meet minimum standards for all of the above, accepted the requirements for participation and attend at least one technical training within a 12-month timeframe, our program manager will provide a Real Estate Ally toolkit to assist in selling high performing homes and list your name to our Real Estate Ally directory.

After application approval, you are eligible to promote your services using the Epic Homes Real Estate Ally badge. The program manager will work with you to ensure your company representatives understand the rules of the program and are promoting the quality standards of our Efficiency Works Homes Contractor Trade Ally Network. As a member of the Epic Homes Real Estate Ally network, Fort Collins Utilities holds the right to survey customers to ensure participants are communicating accurate and up to date information about program standards.

Requirements for Participation

Applicant approval for the Epic Homes Real Estate Ally Network will be effective as of application approval notice and applicant will be subject to these requirements for participation. Approval will continue for a term of one year from the date of the application approval notice and will renew each year an application is received, unless otherwise suspended or terminated in accordance with these requirements.

Once approved, applicants will be listed on the Epic Homes Real Estate Ally webpage as a participating Real Estate Ally.

Once approved, applicants will provide accurate information and guidance to property owners and utility customers about Fort Collins Utilities' energy efficiency programs, including the Epic Certificate.

Applicants must have, and agree to maintain, any state required liability insurance and must provide evidence of any such insurance coverage as requested by Fort Collins Utilities.

Applicants must comply with laws applicable to the real estate profession as required by the Colorado Department of Regulatory Agencies, and continuously maintain all appropriate licenses and certifications for the work they perform in the state of Colorado as a real estate professional. In addition to all other required certifications and licensing, applicants must attend a training designated by the Epic Homes Real Estate Ally program each year.

Upon approval as an Epic Homes Real Estate Ally, applicants agree to indemnify, reimburse, hold harmless and defend Fort Collins Utilities, as well as its directors, officers, employees, agents and designated consultants from any claims of any kind including but not limited to all fees and charges of engineers, architects, attorneys and other professionals and all court or arbitration or other disputed resolution tier or any other entity or person for whom applicant is liable, in the performance or nonperformance of services as a part of this program.

Applicants understand there will be checks to ensure accurate representation of the Epic Certificate. Failure to represent the program accurately may result in termination as an Epic Homes Real Estate Ally. Quality Assurance checks are for program purposes only and no warranty for any purpose is implied.

Upon approval, applicant shall properly assist program participants in promoting the value of home efficiency improvements using a Fort Collins Utilities Epic Certificate. In order to maintain active Epic Homes Real Estate Ally status, applicant shall annually attend an Epic Homes Real Estate Ally continuing education webinar or training.
