Please call local nurseries before visiting them to see what they have in stock from your plant list. Nurseries are based in Fort Collins unless otherwise noted. Seasonal Plant Sales and Swaps

- <u>CO Native Plant Society</u>: Spring Sale in May
- <u>Fall Seed Swaps</u> typically held in October in Fort Collins & Denver: details posted on Wild One's Front Range & CO Native Plant Society event pages in fall
- Garden in a Box: offers several native plant boxes in spring and fall
- <u>Gardens on Spring Creek</u>: Spring Plant Sale in May, members get early access
- <u>Native Plant Swaps</u>: Fort Collins swap is at the <u>Xeriscape Garden Party</u>, but there are also swaps hosted by Wild Ones: Front Range Chapter in Boulder & Denver in May/June
