

## Price, Terms and Conditions 2022



Residents and businesses in Fort Collins can purchase clean, renewable energy for an additional 1.6 cents per kilowatt-hour (kWh) on top of their normal utility bill.

Residential customers can purchase blocks of 200 kWh for \$3.20 per block and non-residential customers can purchase blocks of 1,000 kWh for \$16.00 per block. Both residential and non-residential customers can purchase as many Green Energy blocks as they need or have the option to purchase 100% of their electricity usage.

How will I be billed?

You will receive a monthly Green Energy charge on your bill.

How will my bill be calculated?

Green Energy costs an additional 1.6 cents per kWh, with PILOTS<sup>1</sup>. Green Energy is sold in blocks of 200 kWh or 100% of electricity usage for residential customers and in blocks of 1,000 kWh or 100% of electricity usage for non-residential customers.

<sup>1</sup> PILOTS: payment in lieu of taxes. Without PILOTS, Green Energy costs 1.51 cents per kWh.

Will my rates change over time?	<p>Rates may change each year as the cost to purchase renewable energy sources changes. Rate changes take effect Jan. 1 each year. Subscribers are given notice to change subscription levels prior to the rate change.</p> <p>Historical Green Energy residential rate per kWh with PILOTs:</p> <p>2022 1.6 cents  2021: 1.6 cents  2020: 1.9 cents  2019: 2.65 cents  2018: 2.65 cents  2017: 2.65 cents  2013-2016: 2.54 cents  2010-2012: 2.01 cents</p> <p>The existing rate structure for Utilities Green Energy service is guaranteed through the end of each calendar year.</p>
If I want to terminate this agreement/contract, what is the early termination fee?	No fee will be assessed to terminate the Green Energy subscription.
What length of agreement/contract is required?	Utilities requests a 12-month agreement when agreeing to purchase Green Energy. A 30-day termination period is required.
