

Price, Terms and Conditions 2020



Residents and businesses in Fort Collins can purchase clean, renewable energy for an additional 1.9 cents per kilowatt-hour (kWh) on top of their normal utility bill.*

Residential customers can purchase blocks of 200 kWh for \$3.80 per block and non-residential customers can purchase blocks of 1,000 kWh for \$19.00 per block. Both residential and non-residential customers can purchase as many Green energy blocks as they need or have the option to purchase 100% of their electricity usage.

How will I be billed?

You will receive a monthly Green Energy charge on your bill.

What is the current non-renewable resource mix?

How will my bill be calculated?

Green Energy costs an additional 1.9 cents per kWh, with PILOTS¹. Green Energy is sold in blocks of 200 kWh or 100% of electricity usage for residential customers and in blocks of 1,000 kWh or 100% of electricity usage for non-residential customers.

¹ PILOTS: payment in lieu of taxes. Without PILOTS, Green Energy costs 1.79 cents per kWh

What is the average cost of Green Energy?

Based on a monthly average usage of 700 kWh, the following table provides you an estimate of your 2020 monthly electricity bill if you receive Green Energy from Utilities. Your actual bill will vary based on your use of electricity or block subscription level.

Disclaimer: Green Energy charges are calculated based on 'kWh used.'

(Net meter customers may have additional excess kWh generated that are not included in this calculation.)

Will my rates change over time?

Rates may change each year as the cost to purchase renewable energy sources changes. Rate changes take effect Jan. 1 each year. Subscribers are given notice to change subscription levels prior to the rate change.

Historical Green Energy residential rate per kWh with PILOTS:

- 2020: 1.9 cents
- 2019: 2.65 cents
- 2018: 2.65 cents
- 2017: 2.65 cents
- 2013-2016: 2.54 cents
- 2010-2012: 2.01 cents

The existing rate structure for Utilities Green Energy service is guaranteed through the end of each calendar year.

If I want to terminate this agreement/contract, what is the early termination fee?

No fee will be assessed to terminate the Green Energy subscription.

What length of agreement/contract is required?

Utilities requests a 12-month agreement when agreeing to purchase Green Energy. A 30-day termination period is required.
