
Northeast College Corridor Outfall (NECCO) STORMWATER PROJECT

NECCO Pond is a regional stormwater detention and water quality pond that will provide drainage for stormwater runoff east of College Avenue and north of Vine Drive in the Dry Creek Basin. Some floodplain areas in the Alta Vista neighborhood will be removed as a result of these improvements.

Phase I of the project, large box storm sewer, was completed in May 2017. Phase II will begin construction of the pond located at Suniga Road and Redwood Street and the outfall channel east of the Lindenmeir outfall (see map).

Through a partnership with City Engineering, Utilities will haul excavated material to the location of the future re-aligned Lemay Avenue overpass and roadway bridge at Vine Drive. See map for truck haul routes and location of traffic flaggers. Flagging operations will occur from 8:30 a.m.-3:30 p.m. daily from Jan. 24 until April 2.
